The **aquasource Z-XS** is a fully-equipped ultrafiltration system. Compact and scalable, it has been designed for the municipal, private and industrial sectors. This new system offers a safe and reliable solution replacing old sand filters with a consistent and improved water quality. Our solution is just as competitive as conventional technologies, but also offers an improved and more secure treatment performance.

Ultrafiltration is a physical treatment process which clarifies and disinfects the water in a single step, while maintaining the water's mineral balance. Featuring the ZeeWeed 700B ultrafiltration modules, the aquasource Z-XS guarantees a consistent water quality regardless of variations in the influent water quality.

SevenBore* membranes, PolyEtherSulfone -Inside/Out, are ultraresistant and insensitive to bacterial attacks. The fibres are bundled in groups of 7, which renders the membrane more mechanically resistant than individual fibres.

how it works

The automatic operation of **aquasource Z-XS** ensures a perfect security and easy handling of the unit. The raw water is first prefiltered, preventing the introduction of large particles. It is then sent at low pressure to the ultrafiltration membrane modules. The membrane acts as an absolute barrier for particles larger than 0.02 µm.

The unit will automatically alternate filtration cycles, producing ultrafiltered water, with intermittent flush and backwash which are set based on the inlet water quality.

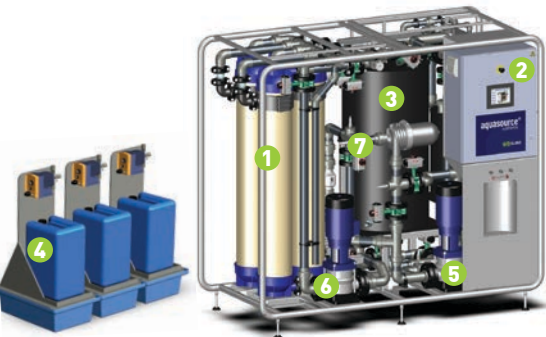
In case of varying inlet water quality, the optional instrumentation allows the unit to adapt its operation and cleaning cycles accordingly.

The aquasource Z-XS unit leverages the broad SUEZ experience in large drinking water production plants with a comprehensive toolkit of flushes, backwashes and cleanings that may involve chemicals (acid, caustic or chlorine). Those different features will be triggered based on the inlet water quality, the unit performance trend and safety parameters set during commissioning.
